

Job Role: Welfare Officer

The Welfare Officer is responsible for promoting safeguarding within Blackheath Lawn Tennis Club (the Club) and working with others to ensure a safe and inclusive environment is achieved.

Please note the Welfare Officer cannot be a member of our coaching team and should not be related to a member of the coaching team (for example, their spouse). The Welfare Officer should be someone over the age of 18.

Main Duties:

- Work with the Officers of the Club to promote safeguarding and ensure compliance with the LTA's minimum standards for venue registration.
- Act as the first point of contact for all children and adults where concerns about welfare, discrimination, poor practice are identified.
- Work with the LTA Safeguarding Team when concerns arise within the Club.
- Maintain contact details with the LTA Safeguarding Team and key statutory agencies.
- Contact the Local Authority children's or adult social care teams and the police about concerns where appropriate.
- Work with the Committee and LTA to facilitate the completion of any action plan to address the results of any concerns.
